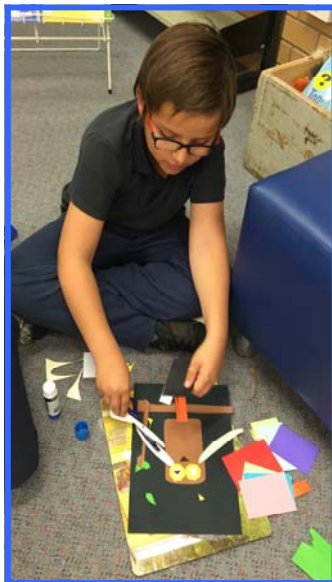
Perch

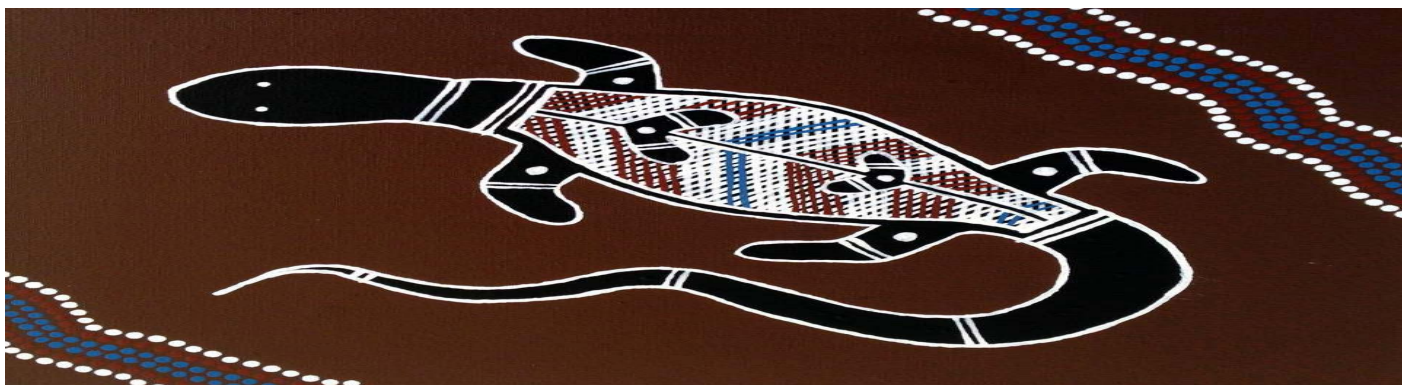
