We all had to wear hair nets in the bakery!



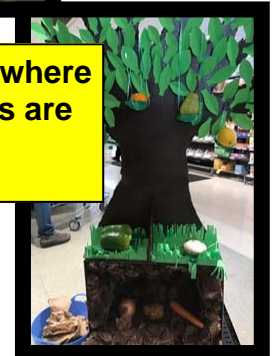
Frankie found out where the new deliveries are kept

Tayla is looking at everyone through the back of the milk fridge!

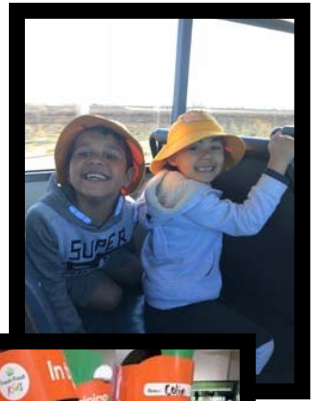
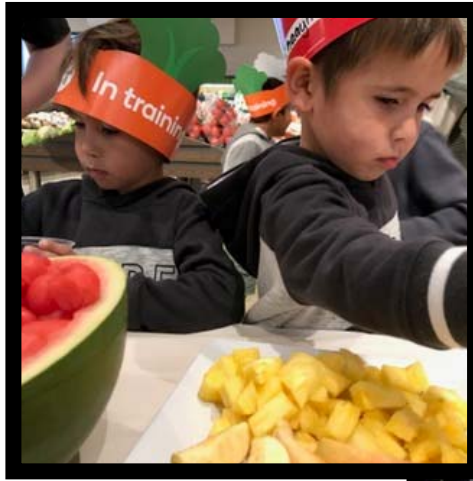


Latron is making a fresh fruit salad.

As we were in Mildura, there were no achievements or Student of the Week certificates awarded.

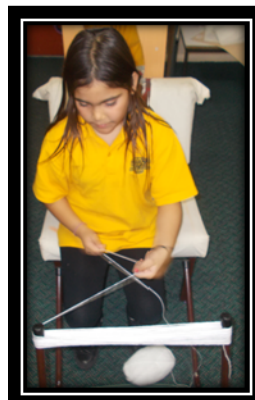
